WORSHIP

From Green to Gold - May 7, 2017

As we opened this month of May this past Monday it was the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. That is always an interesting concept in that we have this month dedicated by the Church to the Blessed Mother, and we celebrate a feast of her husband. In itself that seems quite fitting really, that we would look to him as we realize the role that Mary has in regards to our salvation. As I mentioned here last week this Saturday is First Holy Communion. In addition this Wednesday Bishop Higgins from the Military Archdiocese will be here at St. Veronica's to confirm our eighth graders. May we keep the *Confirmandi* and our second graders in our prayers as they receive these two sacraments and may we invoke the intercession for them of both St. Joseph and our Blessed Mother.

I haven't mentioned this subject in some time but a week ago the NFL held its draft and my Packers picked up 10 players. Most significantly they got a good cornerback and safety in Kevin King and Josh Jones, respectively. They got three running backs and even a player from the Wisconsin Badgers. They were rated an "A" on their choices. Obviously time will tell if these selections have any real impact on the team. In professional sports the player makes a difference, but so does leadership and team spirit. In our spiritual lives something similar is true. Our leadership, the pope, our bishops, and even the pastors of parishes, all can help us grow in holiness. In fact they have a duty to do just that. Some leaders are perhaps more inspiring than others, but their personal holiness makes a difference as well. That is why it is so important to pray for our Holy Father, for our bishop, and for all of us priests. Good leadership fosters better "team spirit," if you will. We truly want to work together, supporting one another, making our parish and diocese an even better one, and assisting those in need. No doubt where we are individually is of the utmost importance. We have to strive for personal holiness each and every day. God's grace is here for us, but we have to avail ourselves to that grace by attending Mass, going to confession regularly, praying daily, and doing good works. This week for our eighth and second graders is yet another example for how God provides His grace to us as the older ones receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit and the younger ones receive the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ for the first time.

Thankfully, the Blessed Mother watches over us and calls us to holiness as well, as she did those three children at Fatima one hundred years ago, as I began discussing here last week. It would be wise of us then to live the message of Our Lady at Fatima. One holy priest (Fr. John Hardon, God rest his soul) once said that the summary of this message is "do whatever He tells you," just what Mary told the wine stewards at that wedding feast at Cana. Fr. Hardon reminded us that we want to be happy here on earth. Sin makes us unhappy, so we need to "stop sinning, repent of your sins and you will enjoy God's blessings in time and eternity." Sadly, for us that is not easy to do, but as we should all know with God's help all things are possible. It does, nonetheless, require our effort as well. We have to work at this. Praying the Rosary for the conversion of others and for our own as well is very helpful. Our world all too often seems to be on a slippery slope towards immorality. Sister Lucia, one of the three children of Fatima, who unlike her two cousins who died shortly after the apparitions, lived until 2005. She died on February 13th of that year, interestingly enough. She said that the issue for mankind would come down to issues related to marriage and family. That seems to be happening, and so we have to keep at this. We don't have to lose hope, but we can't become complacent. I'll continue this discussion in a future column.

Before closing I want to thank all of you who participated in the recent car raffle. We sold tickets totally \$23,900, which means the parish received \$14,340. We are elated that three of our parishioners won prizes, a \$500 one, a \$5000 one, and the GMC Sierra truck. Again, thank you and a special word of gratitude to Chriss and Spencer Rainey, who coordinated the raffle for the parish! \sim In Christ, Fr. Kleinmann
