From Green to Gold – June 4, 2017

It is that time of year when the diocese goes through some transitions. As we all know Bishop Loverde, after about 17 years as our ordinary, retired and Bishop Burbidge was appointed by the pope as our new shepherd in December. Our new bishop told us priests that he was going to make as few changes as possible since he was so new to the diocese and didn't really know all of us priests and the parishes that well. He further said he would only make changes that were necessary. In addition he told us he would give more advance notice than what we have received in the past. That means this past Thursday, June 1st, was the official announcement date. The actual changes will occur at the same time as in the past on the last Wednesday of this new month (the 28th). That means that in three and a half weeks I will have been at St. Veronica's for two years. That also means that Fr. Isenberg will soon be here for four years. After only two years, it was extremely unlikely that I would be moved. As an associate or parochial vicar, a three to four year term is the norm. So it could have been possible that Fr. Isenberg would have been moved, however every indication is that he is *not* being moved. That is good news as far as I am concerned and I certainly hope as far as all of you are concerned as well.

Father continues to be a real blessing to this parish. He is a very hard worker. He is a dedicated priest, who loves his priesthood. He loves the people of this parish and truly cares about your souls. He no doubt has compassion for those in need, but is not overly emotional. It really is a wonderful balance that he has. He is reverent, prayerful, and a true man of God. He fulfills his priestly duties and never hesitates to take on more. His work with the CCD and religious education programs, with the youth, in the school, and at the altar are all outstanding. He has a tremendous concern for the sick, whether in the hospital, one of our nursing homes, or the homebound. He continues to ably guide our Legion of Mary, the Patricians, and our altar servers. He has also been serving as the chairman of the principal search committee and has done a great job overseeing that as well. Beyond his priestly work, he also continues to handle numerous IT and engineering issues here at the parish. This really is an added bonus, especially with my almost complete lack of knowledge of this area. He also has been a tremendous sounding board for me since my arrival here. He had two years more experience at the parish than I did and has been a very good source of advice and information. You can see, I hope, why I am so very pleased he is here and why I am thrilled he is staying for another year. I am extremely grateful to him and greatly appreciate all he does. I truly believe in some ways he is a much better priest than I am. I have learned from him, as I hope he has learned a few things from me. Please join me in offering our prayers to the Lord, first in thanksgiving for Fr. Isenberg and secondly that He continues to bless him and his work here, especially as he celebrates the anniversary of his ordination this Thursday and his birthday the next day on Friday.

In regards to changes that already have been announced, again none here at St. Veronica's, Fr. Krempa, who has been pastor at Sacred Heart in Winchester for 18 years and who was my pastor my last year there, will be the pastor of the newly established parish of St. Bridget's in Berryville. It had been a mission of Sacred Heart. In addition very near us, the parish from which we broke off, and also after 18 years there Fr. Weymes is retiring as the pastor of St. Timothy's. Both Sacred Heart and St. Timothy's will need new pastors, who should have been appointed and announced this past Thursday. May we pray for these priests and parishes and for all of those who were affected by any changes this past week!

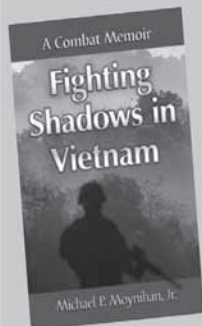
