From Green to Gold – June 18, 2017

Two Saturdays ago I had the privilege of attending the priesthood ordination ceremony for our diocese. Fr. Isenberg attended the diaconate ordinations the week before where he MC'ed the ceremony as well. On June 10th three priests were ordained for Arlington, Fr. Jordan Willard, Fr. Steven Oetjen, and Fr. Stephen Vaccaro. This was Bishop Burbidge's first priesthood ordination ceremony for our diocese. I do not know Fr. Willard at all, but I do have a connection to the other two. Fr. Oetjen attended St. Mary's School while I was there. He and his family weren't members of the parish; they belonged to St. Lawrence in Alexandria. I have known the Vaccaro family for twenty-four years and am good friends with Father's older brother who is also a priest of our diocese. Fr. Christopher Vaccaro was ordained eight years ago. As it always is, the ceremony was beautiful; it is very moving. If you have never attended an ordination I would strongly encourage you to do so next year. We certainly want to pray for our new priests and the two deacons who were ordained on June 3rd and for Nick Schierer, who will be ordained a deacon in Rome in September. We also want to pray for our summer seminarian, John O'Farrell, who has now arrived at St. Veronica's. He will be involved in a number of parish activities. As I mentioned here last week, please introduce yourselves to him.

One of the reasons we pray for these new priests and future priests is that without them we do not have the Eucharist. As the priest (or bishop) is the only one who can consecrate the Eucharist, we need them. On this Corpus Christi Sunday, that is particularly significant, for today we celebrate the central mystery of our Catholic Faith. Last week with the feast of the Most Holy Trinity we marked the central mystery of the Christian Faith. This week we remember that Our Lord gave us His very Body and Blood. At the Last Supper Jesus took that bread and said "This is My Body." Then He took the wine and said, "This is My Blood." We actually believe Him; we take Him at His word. That is why we show such respect for the Eucharist. Thus we genuflect when we come into church. That is also why we show reverence while in church rather than discussing a recent Packer win or a Redskins loss. That is why in addition we try to be on time for Mass and not leave early and why we try to dress appropriately. As the weather has warmed up considerably, some might be tempted to wear clothing more fitting of the beach or a backyard barbecue (or as we would say in Wisconsin, a "grill out"). That typically should not be the case as Our Lord deserves better. That clothing does not have to be expensive, but it truly should be our "Sunday best." We refrain from eating or drinking anything for one hour prior to receiving Holy Communion, the only exceptions being water and medicine.

When it comes to receiving Holy Communion we need to prepare our minds and souls as well. Our minds will be prepared if we try to be engaged at Mass, saying the prayers, listening to the readings and homily, using the moments of silence for reflection on what a great gift God is giving us. We also prepare by making a last act of reverence before literally receiving the Host. We do that by a bow, the sign of the Cross, a genuflection, or kneeling. Then we receive on the tongue, which I would say is a preferred way, or in the hand, but doing so properly. We should say "Amen," which means "I believe with my whole being." We prepare our souls by being in the state of grace. In other words if we have a mortal sin on our soul, we need to go to confession first. All of this indicates that we believe that the Eucharist is Jesus Christ. Again, what a gift! Finally, please join us today for the Corpus Christi procession and a very happy and blessed Fathers' Day to all of our fathers, grandfathers, and Godfathers.


