WORSHIP

From Green to Gold - July 9, 2017

As we continue through summer and as I mentioned here last week we can try to enjoy this more relaxing time of the year. That is at least the hope, that these summer days are a time of a slower pace and vacations. As I also commented last week, we can't take a vacation, however, from our vocation or calling to be holy, so we maintain our lives of prayer. In fact with the more relaxed sense of things perhaps we can spend even more time in prayer. There are all kinds of opportunity to fulfill this duty before God. In addition, we need to keep up with our works of mercy. I did list a few speakers and collections that are on the horizon here at St. Veronica's. I want to provide a little more detail on all of what is coming in the weeks ahead.

The Sabat Mater group, for instance, will be soliciting help this weekend to fund their activities for Hispanic youth. A week ago they held a summer camp here at the parish. Two weeks from now we will have Fr. Posey, pastor of St. James in Falls Church, director of the diocesan Missions Office, and a former pastor of our diocesan mission in the Dominican Republic, here to preach all the Masses and raise funds for that particular outreach. The following weekend (July 29-30) Mary Kate VanderWoude, the niece of the pastor of Holy Trinity in Gainesville, will be here to talk about FOCUS, the college outreach group. Then the weekend of August 12th-13th representatives from Crossroads will be here. This is the Pro-Life group who marches across the U.S. to raise an awareness of the sanctity of all human life, especially the unborn. That same weekend the second collection is for children in the diocese who have special needs. In part they fund the Options program at Paul VI High School. Finally the second collection this week is for the people of Africa, who no doubt are in desperate need of assistance. This is our opportunity to help them, as the others above provide further opportunities.

This coming Wednesday, July 12th, is the feast of our parish patroness. Unfortunately, this feast is not on the official Church calendar. To be honest with you for that reason it simply did not occur to me last year, and we let that day pass with no festivity or recognition of this saint. I do apologize for that. I didn't want that to happen again this year. We will recognize her at Mass that day and here in the bulletin. Although St. Veronica doesn't explicitly appear in the Bible, some do think the hemorrhaging woman who touches the hem of Jesus' garment and is healed might be Veronica, tradition does accept her as authentic. She is one of the women from Jerusalem who accompanied Our Lord on His way to Calvary. Along that way, moved by compassion, she approached Jesus and wiped from His face the sweat, spit, and mud that had collected on it. In return an image of His face was imprinted on her veil. Legend has it that she was later summoned to Rome by Emperor Tiberius who in turn was cured of his illness when Veronica touched her veil and the sacred image of Jesus' face to the emperor. She then remained in Rome and gave her veil at her death to Pope Clement. It later was enshrined in St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican.

Another story involving the Veil of St. Veronica revolves around Sr. Marie of St. Peter, a Carmelite, who beginning in 1844 received visions from Christ during which He asked for devotion to His Holy Face. This was to be in reparation for the sacrileges and blasphemies committed against Jesus. Jesus also told her our sins add to the spit and mud He encountered during His Passion. Devotion then to the Holy Face of Jesus and to the Veil of St. Veronica help move us to a more holy place and away from sin. This devotion was approved by Pope Leo XIII in 1885. We will have a short reception honoring our patroness after the 8:30 am Mass that morning. I'll say a few more words about her here next week. St. Veronica, pray for us.

*Because the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel falls on a Sunday this year, the liturgy for the Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time take precedence.

On July 16, 1251 at Aylesford in Kent, England, according to tradition, Our Lady appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a Carmelite monk, promising that whoever wore her "habit" devoutly would be assured of eternal salvation. 




