## WORSHIP

### *From Green to Gold – September 10, 2017*

Last week here I commented about the NFL preseason coming to an end as well as the end unofficially of summer. I mentioned that I did not yet know the results of the last games of the Packers and Redskins. Both won, but as I also mentioned, these preseason games, wins or losses, mean little other than allowing us a chance to see what each team's potential is for the regular season. Well for both teams that regular season begins today (Sunday). The Packers play against Seattle at 4:25 pm in Green Bay, and the Redskins faceoff against the Eagles at FedEx, and so another year begins. It does with high hopes and great expectations. Many are predicting that Washington will not match their recent past performance and may end up the season sitting at the bottom of their division. In regards to the Packers, many are wondering whether they can take their division again this year or whether it will go to the Detroit Lions. Again, there are high hopes and great expectations, just like it is when it comes to our spiritual lives. We have those high hopes that we truly can grow in holiness. In addition we have great expectations that we can do better than we did over the summer months, now that we don't have all of the distractions that that warmer time of the year can bring. If our teams play well we will be thrilled. If we really apply ourselves spiritually we will also have reason to be thrilled, and no doubt God will be as well.

When it comes to our faith, obviously it is up to us. Will we pray more? Will we pray with greater fervency? Will we try to read the Scriptures daily or turn to a book on some religious topic? If not already, could we attend daily Mass and will we? Can we try to make Sunday, the Lord's Day, a day of true rest, prayer, and family time? Will we seek out or attend some of the different opportunities St. Veronica's is offering, be that That Man Is You, Endow, the Spirituality Apostolate, the Knights, the Wednesday evening Holy Hour, Adoration, or even the upcoming Food, Farm, and Faith Dinner or Oktoberfest? There are many ways of living our Faith and deepening our love for God and our neighbor. So are we making the effort to do so?

Another opportunity to pray is to participate in the "Rosary Novena for Our Nation." This program actually began almost a month ago on the feast of the Assumption, August 15<sup>th</sup>. It concludes on the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, October 7<sup>th</sup>. This effort is sponsored by the Holy League, a parish-based group of Catholic men who devote themselves to the Blessed Sacrament and a holy way of living. It was founded by Fr. Richard Heilman, who grew up in Madison, Wisconsin and is a priest of that diocese as well as a pastor and a regular on Catholic radio. The Holy League recognizes the current state of affairs of our country. Whether it is the general moral decay our nation has been undergoing for some time now, the threat of war with North Korea, the hatred espoused by certain groups on both the right and the left, or the tremendous damage caused by recent hurricanes, there should be no question we have much for which to pray. Thus this group is encouraging us to pray the Rosary everyday (if we are not already). Additionally, the Holy League is encouraging everyone to be enrolled in the Brown Scapular and to consecrate themselves to Jesus through Mary. This special devotion to the Blessed Mother seems quite appropriate as we continue through this 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of the appearance of Our Lady at Fatima and as we approach the month of October, the month of the Holy Rosary. Their words of encouragement are stated well: The time is now to call upon God, through the powerful intercession of Our Lady of the Rosary, to heal our nation and return it to holiness. Please pray it is so!

The Virginia Education Improvement Scholarship Tax Credit Program awards a 65% tax credit to individuals or businesses that make a monetary donation to an approved foundation.

- The Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation is an approved foundation under this program.
- The donation will be used to provide scholarships to low income new students to our Catholic schools.
- These donations, in addition to giving you, the donor, a tax benefit, will provide a life-changing education for our new students.

## **Frequently Asked Questions About How to Donate**

### **Who is eligible for the tax credit?**

An individual or business entity may receive a tax credit for eligible donations.

### **What kind of donations qualify for the credit?**

Eligible donations include monetary donations by cash, checks, or marketable securities. Donations of goods, services or property are not eligible for the tax credit.

### **How are donations limited?**

In order to receive a tax credit donors must contribute a minimum of \$500. For individuals, including married couples, eligible maximum donation is \$125,000 per taxable year. Therefore, the maximum tax credit of an individual's donation is \$81,250 (65% of \$125,000). Business entities, including sole proprietorships, have no donation limitations.

### **How does a donor apply for a tax credit?**

In order to qualify for the tax credit, donors must request preauthorization for their donation from the Department of Education. Donations made without preauthorization will not be eligible for the tax credit. Preauthorization requests are processed on a first come, first served basis and are only granted for the first \$25 million in total donations. The Department of Education will issue a preauthorization notice to the donor indicating approval of their donation.

### **How does a donor obtain a Preauthorization form?**

2. Please follow the instructions on the Preauthorization Request Form and mail the form to the VA DOE address shown on the form. VA DOE will then send you a Preauthorization Approval Form for your donation
3. Once you receive the Preauthorization Approval Form from the VA DOE (form has a 6 character code at the top) complete Part 1 of this form, sign it and mail it with your check to:

4. Please make checks payable to: **Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation**. If the donation is marketable securities, please contact us for a stock donation form and instructions.
5. An acknowledgment letter from the Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation will be sent to you for your charitable tax deduction.
6. The State of Virginia will send a tax credit certificate directly to you. The tax credit may be claimed for the same tax year in which the donation is made. Any unused tax credits may be carried over for the next five succeeding tax years or until the total amount of the credit has been taken, whichever is sooner.
