## WORSHIP

Although we quickly approach fall, it doesn’t start until September 22<sup>nd</sup>. I have attended the two most recent ones and am quite impressed with the wonderful evening of good food, good drink, some interesting speakers, and a great chance to socialize with fellow parishioners. There is a cost of \$65.00, which covers everything and is not a bad price for all that is included. The following Sunday is our parish’s Oktoberfest. This is again sponsored by the PTO and our parish Knights of Columbus council. 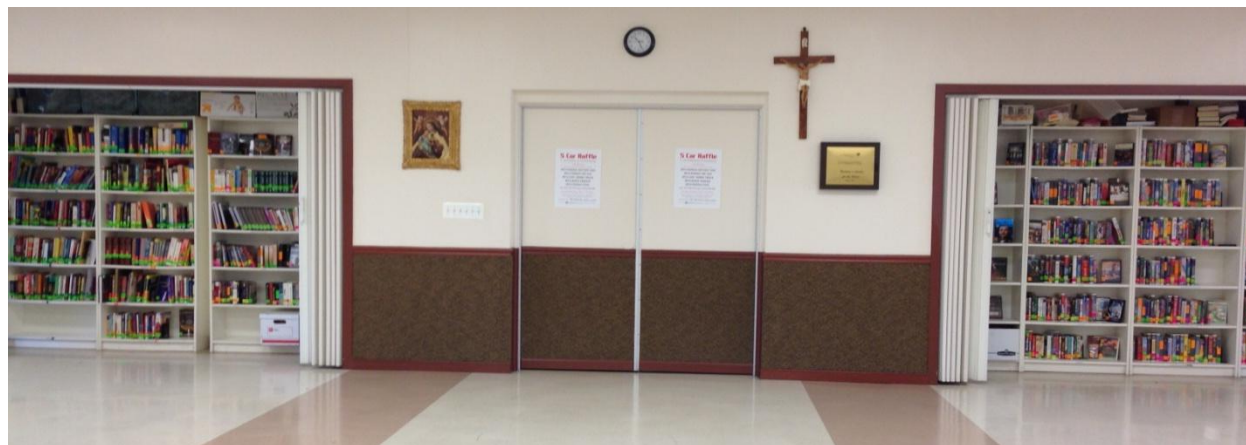

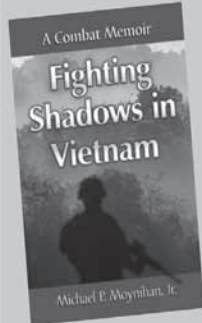
