Responsibilities of WorkCamp Youth Participants

- Complete and return paperwork and fees in a timely manner.
- Participate in the planning/preparation meetings and fundraising activities.
- Work to create a sense of community with all those attending from our parish.
- Obtain the necessary tools to be used during the WorkCamp week.
- During WorkCamp, follow all guidelines and procedures.

Adult Volunteers

Adults can get involved by:

- Volunteering to spend the full week with the teens as an adult crew leader on a work site.
- Volunteering to come Monday-Thursday as a contractor. Professional contracting experience is not necessary, only the handyman experience to lead a group of energetic teens with power tools.
- Volunteering to serve as security on the night that our parish is assigned.
- Helping with fundraising and preparations before WorkCamp.

Selection of **P**articipants

Participants will be chosen as follows:

- Must actively participate in their faith with Sunday Mass and personal prayer.
- Maturity level and ability to work in a group.
- Ability to attend all the required preparation meetings and fundraising events.
- No application will be accepted after December 30th.

Payment

- \$475 total due per participant
- Through group fundraising, we hope to substantially reduce or eliminate the amount due.
- Group fundraising has the added benefit of building teamwork, which is necessary for WorkCamp.
- Most of the participant fee goes into purchasing the building materials needed on the work site. Some provides breakfast and dinner for the week and evening program costs.
