From Green to Gold - January 7, 2018

Welcome to 2018! It is a new year. I have returned from Wisconsin. School is back in session. Our new altar has been consecrated. Life probably in general has returned to the non-holiday routine we are more used to. And neither the Packers nor the Redskins are in the playoffs. Hopefully everyone had a wonderful Christmas season, which liturgically ends tomorrow (Monday, the 8th) with the feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. Traditionally, the Christmas Season extends until February 2nd, the feast of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple or Candlemas Day. This is why we will keep up some of our Christmas decorations and have a closing Christmas hymn on Sunday Masses until then. This weekend we celebrate the Epiphany or the coming of the Three Wise Men (Magi). Some refer to this day as "Little Christmas." Some exchange their presents on this day as it's the day according to Sacred Scripture that the Christ Child was presented gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. As there were three gifts, it is presumed there were three Magi from the East. Tradition (not Scripture) tells us that their names were Balthasar, Melchior, and Casper. This is also the day that we invoke the Lord's blessing on our homes. The custom comes from the idea that the Three Wise Men came to Jesus and were His guests, as such they were blessed. Now we ask that Christ be our guest in our homes; that He come to us. There is blessed chalk again available here at the church which you can take home with you. Using that chalk you write above your home's entrance, 20 + C + M + B + 18. The letters are the initials of the Magi and also are the first letters of the Latin words, Christus mansionem benedicat, which means "May Christ bless the house." The year is included (2018) and so is the cross (+).

Briefly, after saying nothing about sports for a couple of weeks, my Packers basically crashed and burned. I write this before their final game which was Dec. 31st. Aaron Rodgers did make his come back, but lost the game against the Panthers. Although he threw for three touchdowns, he also threw three interceptions. With a Falcons win that following Monday night they were out of the playoffs. This is the first year since 2008, that they haven't been involved in the post-season. What can I say, but such is life. Things don't always go as we plan, and we have to work with that. Sports may have some bearing, but not much, on our moral lives, so we have to move on. Somewhat similarly, we waited nearly nine months for our new altars, ambo, and baptismal font. Again, because I write this in advance of my trip home to Wisconsin, we were still missing the font, and there was some finish up work on the other pieces. All of that should have been done while I was gone. I'll comment on that more and the consecration of the altar next week.

I did want to return to Christmas, specifically to offer some words of gratitude. I think everything went well two weekends ago. It was an interesting weekend to some extent with the Fourth Sunday of Advent the day before Christmas Day. But again, as far as I could tell, everything worked out well. The Christmas Masses were beautiful. The music was outstanding. The church was stunning, despite the temporary altar. As I say above, we worked with it. In that regard then I do want to thank our sacristans, the floral director, the money counters, the lectors, the musicians, the servers, the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, the parish staff, and anyone else who helped in any way. That would also include Gianna Farina, the young girl who bought up the Baby Jesus at Midnight Mass. Everything really worked well to help us celebrate the birth of Our Lord. I do also want to thank all of you who sent cards, greetings, and all kinds of goodies to us clergy. You were very generous, and everything was wonderful. We pray that God blesses all of you throughout this New Year.

Baltimore Catechism Extracts

On Sin and Its Kinds

- Q. Is Original Sin the only kind of sin?
- Α. Original Sin is not the only kind of sin; there is another kind of sin which we commit ourselves, called actual sin.
- Q. What is actual sin?
- Actual sin is any willful thought, word, Α. deed, or omission contrary to the law of God.






