# WORSHIP

## FROM GREEN TO GOLD—MARCH 8, 2020

As we continue through this Lenten season, a penitential time of increased prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we strive for greater holiness preparing for the glory of Easter, which is five weeks away, and for the glory of heaven someday. This began two Wednesdays ago when we in the sign of the cross marked our foreheads with ashes. This was to remind us that we will indeed someday die and we need to be ready to meet Our Lord. We know not the day nor the hour, as Jesus Himself tells us, so thankfully we have the 40 days of Lent to focus us on this all the more. Ironically perhaps, on Ash Wednesday five, really six, men lost their lives in Milwaukee. The national news covered this tragic event. Sadly, it is only one of many situations that have involved multiple killings over the past number of years in our country. It is not the first to affect the Milwaukee area. In 2005 seven people were killed and others injured during a church service. Four years later three people were killed and others were injured at a women's hair salon, and that same year six people were killed and others injured at a Sikh temple. These kind of things have become all too common, almost tempting us to not be overly bothered by them. There was the attack on the country music concert in Las Vegas in 2017, the Orlando nightclub shooting in 2016, the Sandy Hook school shooting in 2012, the church attack in Texas in 2017, the shooting at Virginia Tech in 2007, the one at a Walmart in Texas less than a year ago, the shootings at the Navy Yard in D.C. in 2013, and the one in Virginia Beach almost a year ago. The list goes on and no doubt raises all kinds of questions, politically and morally. The point is we don't know when one of these kinds of horrific acts may occur or when we by natural means will face death and so, again, we have to be prepared. Lent in a profound way reminds us of this and helps us to do it.

To my surprise that episode in Milwaukee almost two weeks ago, seemed to have a great effect on me. I didn't know anyone that was involved. I never worked at that brewery (or any other for that matter). Yet, personally this did have an impact on me. I might be getting a little sentimental here, but as many of you know, Milwaukee is my home city. It is where I was born and raised. All my family (Dad, seven brothers and sisters, all but one of 20 nieces and nephews) live in the Milwaukee area. I tell people my soul is in Virginia, but my heart is in Wisconsin. This Midwestern state and city will always have a special place in my heart. That shooting on February 26<sup>th</sup> occurred at the sprawling MolsonCoors campus, as it is now called. For a century and a half it has been referred to as the Miller Brewery. The iconic red Miller sign sits on top of the tallest building that is part of the complex and is visible from miles away. The brewery covers multiple blocks in the western part of the city. I have driven by there hundreds of times. When you think of Milwaukee most people think of beer, and when you think of Milwaukee beer most people think of Miller, even though there are about 50 breweries in the Milwaukee area. By far Miller is the king, however! Even the city's baseball team is called the Brewers, and their stadium is Miller Field. This brewery is one of the largest in the U.S. in terms of beer produced and with its 1400 employees. Miller and its distributors sponsor many Catholic church festivals each year. In fact many of those churches have a "Miller tent." Additionally, Frederick Miller, the founder of the brewery, and his descendants were Catholic. Many went to Notre Dame University, and the grandson of Frederick founded the largest Catholic charitable foundation in the world with the proceeds of the sale of the brewery. These Catholic roots go deep, so I guess that is also why this just seems so personal. But that again should help to prompt us to really take Lent seriously and to make it personal, for our salvation in part depends on what we do these 40 days of Lent! ~ In Christ, Fr. Kleinmann

## HELP LEAD OTHERS OUT OF DARKNESS

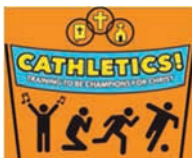

## St. Anthony of Padua Lenten Service Project

### New for 2020 - Lenten Service Project

In a letter to the faithful, Archbishop Cordileone challenged us to look more closely at almsgiving during Lent. "How do people know we love them? When we love, we act: we comfort, we help, we show we care....We redouble our efforts during Lent, in a very focused way, in order to develop our spiritual stamina for living our faith well throughout the year. This is how we show both Jesus and our neighbor we love them."

This Lent students and teachers will team up after school to put our faith into action and turn plastic bags into sleeping mats to comfort people experiencing homelessness. We will take donated bags, turn them into "plarn" and turn that material into a sleeping surface that is lightweight, insulating and easy to clean.

How can else can you help? Hundreds of plastic bags are needed for each mat. We're asking families (preK – 8) to send in all those plastic grocery and merchandise bags that can't be added to home recycle bins. We will recycle them into a soft, sturdy and weather-proof mats. As Benedict XVI reminded us in his encyclical Caritas in Veritate (Charity in Truth), "The environment is God's gift to everyone, and in our use of it we have a responsibility towards the poor, towards future generations and towards humanity as a whole..."





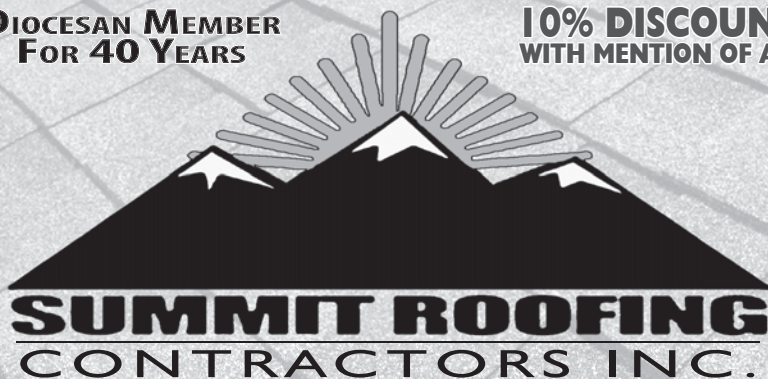
